Our Young Religious UUs (9-12 Graders) will meet most Sunday evenings from 7-9 p.m. and will have special programming at other times throughout the year.

Children's Fellowship Activities will be offered during our service times this year. Parent's and children are welcome to attend worship services together or children can join us for fellowship activities after the Together Time at the beginning of the service. ***There is a registration fee of \$20 for the first child registered, \$10 for each additional child up to a maximum of \$40/family.\**** Please make checks payable to AUUC with "RE Registration" in the memo line.

This fee covers only a small portion of the total cost of the program with the remaining costs provided by congregant pledges to the church's Annual Pledge. Registration fees may be waived, please contact the Director of Lifespan Education for more information.
